

SCHOOL COUNSELING GRADUATE OPTION

This option is offered within the following major(s):

Available only at OSU-Cascades and via Ecampus.

The Master of Counseling (MCOUN) degree with a School Counseling option uses a competency-based approach to preparing school counselors. The program prepares the counselor to provide comprehensive school counseling programs that serve all students. Counselors will learn to utilize strategies to work with their students' academic, personal/social, and career development needs. Preparation consists of a sequential program that integrates academic knowledge and theory with closely supervised counseling practice. Self-exploration and personal development are integral components of the program.

Graduates are eligible for an Oregon School Counselor License upon completion of additional steps required by the Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission. These steps may include completion of COUN 582 and/or COUN 591.
