

MANAGERIAL ECONOMICS OPTION

The Managerial Economics option is an interdisciplinary program which allows students to use business classes toward the requirements of the economics degree. - All students must receive a grade of "C" (2.00) or better in all upper-division required courses and must maintain an overall grade-point average (GPA) of 2.00 in all courses taken toward the Law, Economics and Policy option
- None of the 51 credits may be taken S/U
- Students cannot receive credit toward the option for both ECON 311 and ECON 411, for both ECON 315 and ECON 415, and for both ECON 424 and ECON 427
- No more than 4 credits of self-study courses (ECON 401–ECON 410) may be counted toward the 51 credit requirement
